Free Tax Filing Assistance for Seniors

Happy new year! In other words, tax season is coming. If you are looking for some help filing your taxes this year, the Naperville Park District offers free tax filing assistance for seniors, 50 years and older. They have volunteers trained through the AARP tax-aid program to help in the upcoming months. You must register for a 45-minute appointment time and will be asked to bring all your paperwork with you. Senior Home Fire Safety Survey

To keep Naperville seniors safe, the Naperville Fire Department provides no-cost Senior Home Fire Safety surveys to seniors living independently who request a visit.

These surveys identify home features that might make your residence susceptible to fire or injuries due to falls and will also advise on ways to eliminate or reduce hazards. Every home visit includes a written home safety survey with smoke detectors (if needed), a carbon monoxide detector, kitchen fire extinguisher, and other goodies.
